



Investigator of the Year

Who can nominate an investigator?

Anyone can nominate an investigator for the award, i.e. fire/police chief, fire marshal, colleague, etc. A nomination form shall be completed and accompanied by a letter explaining why this person should be considered for the award.

Investigator of the Year Award

Investigator of the Year Award is given to an individual who is an active member of the FL-IAAI and who has shown outstanding achievement through the use of professional expertise in both the criminal and civil fields of arson control. The recipient shall not be a current officer or member of the Board of Directors, nor shall the recipient be a member of the Awards Committee. There shall be one annual Investigator of the Year. Anyone can nominate an investigator for the award, i.e. fire or police chief, fire marshal, colleague, etc. A nomination form shall be completed and accompanied by a letter explaining why this person should be considered for the award. Nomination Forms must be postmarked no later than September 30th of each year. Applications postmarked after that date will not be considered.
